Sealed Bids for 2020 Water Main Improvements, will be received by the Northwestern Water & Sewer District, at the District's Office, 12560 Middleton Pike, Bowling Green, Ohio 43402, until 11:00 AM, local time, on May 12, 2020 at which time they will be publicly opened and read.
