Sealed Bids for CSO Structure Modifications Eagleville Road, will be received by the Village of North Baltimore, Ohio, at the Village Administration, 205 North Main Street, North Baltimore, Ohio 45872, until 2:00 pm, local time, on October 8, 2025, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

In general, the work consists of removing and replacing the existing cast-in-place top slab of the chamber and installing new access manholes. A new weir wall will be constructed to separate the west and east halves, along with a manually operated non-rising stem slide gate accessible via a valve box. Additionally, a float-based level monitoring system with a solar-powered indicator light will be installed to alert the Village of high-water conditions, and a method for measuring bypassed flow will be implemented.

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 90 days after the actual opening thereof.
