ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

To be submitted in a sealed envelope, marked “**BID FOR (City of Lima, Ohio; Mumaugh Road Pump Station Replacement & Cable Road Pump Station Replacement)**” to the Mayor of the City of Lima, Ohio, attention Purchasing Department of the City of Lima, Ohio; Municipal Center, 50 Town Square, Lima, Ohio 45801, before 10:00 a.m., Lima Time, on Thursday, January 9, 2020 . At which time, they will be publicly opened and read. Outside of envelope not being properly marked may result in Bid not being received, by the Purchasing Department, before the deadline, and could result in Bid being disqualified. Please complete all forms included in the Bid Specifications. Forms not being filled out correctly and/or completely may result in Bid being disqualified.

In general, the work consists of the replacement of the City’s existing Mumaugh Road pump station and existing Cable Road Pump Station. The new submersible duplex stations will replace the existing steel can dry well stations.

Bids must be submitted on the forms bound herein, must contain the names of every person or company interested therein, and shall be accompanied by either a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in the amount of 100% of the amount bid with satisfactory corporate surety, or by a certified check on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the Bid, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance Bond and Maintenance and Guarantee Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid.

This procurement is subject to the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of Small Business in Rural Areas (SBRAs). The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed most favorable to the Owner.

The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the prevailing wage rates established by the Federal Davis-Bacon Wage Determinations issued by the U.S. Department of Labor.

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 90 days after the actual opening thereof.

The City of Lima reserves the right to waive any Bid or Bid process irregularities, which the City determines in its sole discretion to be in its favor, to reject any or all Bids for any reason determined to be appropriate in the sole discretion of the City, and to award the Bid to the lowest and best bidder meeting the City's needs as determined by the City at the City's sole discretion.
