In general, the work consists of storm and sanitary sewer improvements, water line replacement, and roadway reconstruction on Maple Grove Avenue between Douglas and Taney Streets.

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 60 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is based on the best interest of the City.
